






Guide to cleaning stainless steel sink with Steel Clean cream

 Why treat the stainless steel sink Daily use of the sink can cause the appearance of whitish, iridescent or rust-like stains. These signs do not indicate poor quality of the steel, but are the result of:

- evaporation of water (mineral residues)
- washing residues or products not rinsed properly
- contact with liquids such as salt, lemon juice, tomato juice or cooking water



What you need

-  Crema Steel Clean (cod. 8331 000)
-  Foster microfibre cloth (code 8333 000)
-  Running water for rinsing
-  Dry cloth for final drying

Step-by-step procedure

- Pour an adequate amount of cream on the surface to be treated



Foster

- Rub firmly using a microfiber cloth, following the brushing direction of the steel.



Continue rubbing until the cream forms a light white powdery layer.



- During treatment, the cloth may turn dark grey: this is normal, it indicates that the cream is working.



- Rinse thoroughly with water to remove any residue.



- Dry with a second dry microfiber cloth.




Stubborn stains or corrosion (Pitting)

In case of localized corrosion or stubborn stains, the treatment can be repeated several times to obtain an optimal result.

Important Notes

- Do not use abrasive sponges or aggressive products.
- Keep the cream out of the reach of children.
- Perform the treatment periodically to keep the natural protection of the steel intact.
